Driver Safety Pledge *(Please complete and bring with you the day of the ride)*

hereby pledge to keep **safety first** during the Sedalia Sunrise Optimist Tractor Cruise 2008. The safety of my fellow riders, and the public traveling on the route, is of the utmost importance. I pledge to obey the following rules:

- To hold a valid **Drivers License**. *We will check your license during registration. Please have yours ready to show when you check in!*
- To have **Liability Insurance** and be prepared to show at registration. Liability is usually extended under your homeowners policy or farm liability policy. *Please have yours ready to show when you check in!*
- To follow all City, County and State traffic laws.
- To have an anchored seat for my buddy rider.
- To stay with my assigned group – no passing unless for a breakdown.
- To depart during my assigned group's designated time.
- To follow the designated route.
- To have good working brakes and tight steering.
- To drive on the shoulder as needed.
- To not have bicycle companions
- To not pull campers or oversized equipment. Wagon, or carts are permitted. 8 ft maximum width.
- To post **Slow Moving Vehicle** signs.
- To abide by the decisions of the Tractor Cruise Management Team, based on information from the National Weather Service, in the event of inclement weather.
- NO** alcoholic beverages during the tractor ride.
- Rearview Mirror and Fire Extinguisher are required.**
- A safety inspection will be conducted on each entry.

I understand breaking these rules will result in the immediate termination of the Cruise and denial of all future applications.

What do you do if a tractor breaks down?

Tractors that come on our ride are in sound shape when they come. Some, however, will have a bad day on occasion. If this happens, we have "sag wagons" and mechanics that will come and load the tractor or make a quick repair to keep each driver moving. Spark plugs and fuel filters are the most common problems, along with the occasional empty tank of fuel. **Should you or another tractor breakdown, do not ask for or give another driver a tow, let the "sag wagon" handle any breakdown problems.**

What if someone has a medical emergency?

The first thing we do, of course, is to call emergency service. We have implemented a program that has the driver's shared medical information on the back of their name badge. This way, if something happens to someone, we'll still be able to possibly pinpoint the problem. We're also fortunate to have the assistance of Sheriff's Departments, City Police, City Fire, Volunteer Fire Departments and the Missouri State Highway Patrol helping us on our Cruise. The work of these men and women on the front lines and behind the scenes helps the event run smoothly. (Please thank these folks whenever you see them throughout the day.)

What about guests and family members who want to eat lunch on either day?

If you are riding in a buddy seat or wagon, you may purchase your lunch under the Guest Single Ticket Price on the registration form. We are not allowing support vehicles for individuals to travel with the tractors. You may join the Tractor Cruise at the lunch stops by an alternate route that will not complicate the ride. (A map will be provided to the lunch stop locations) We appreciate your help in this matter to make the ride a fun and memorable time.

What about rest stops?

We will plan a rest stop in the morning and afternoon along the route.

Will check-in be available on Friday evening?

We will have a table set up to handle Friday evening for check in, which will improve the start time Saturday morning. Registration Friday night is from 5pm - 9pm. Registration Saturday and Sunday 7am - 8am. Inspections will be done at check in when possible.

Where is the Missouri State Fair Grounds located?

The Missouri State Fair Grounds is located at the southwest intersection of South 65 Highway. and 16th Street (also Y Highway). Entry to the Fairgrounds will be made through Gate 5 which is located on 16th Street (across from the Pittsburgh Corning Plant) A map of Sedalia is included in your Sedalia Missouri Visitors Guide which is included in this packet.
